

THE HOLBERG PRIZE NOMINATION FORM

The Holberg Prize is awarded annually to a scholar who has made outstanding contributions to research in the arts and humanities, social sciences, law or theology. The Prize may be awarded both for work within a particular discipline and for work of a cross disciplinary nature. The prize winner must have had a decisive influence on international research.

The nomination deadline is 15 June each year.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS:

- It is not possible to nominate groups or organizations.
- Self-nominations and post-humous nominations are not accepted.
- Nominations of established scholars below the age of seventy are particularly encouraged.
- Joint nominations do not strengthen a candidacy.
- Nominations are strictly confidential and should not be disclosed to the nominee or to others at any time.

THE NOMINATION FORM

We strongly advice that you use the online nomination form to submit your nomination. You can save the form and continue later, if you wish. There is no time limit for how long you can spend on each page. In the form we ask that you provide the following information:

- A nomination statement of 1000-3000 characters (incl. spaces) justifying why the candidate should receive the Holberg Prize.
- The candidate's CV and publication list.
- Names of three possible referees who know the candidate's work and who can provide additional information if needed.

In this field we ask that you briefly describe the candidate's most important academic achievements, how her/his work has influenced research and why she/he is a worthy candidate to receive the Holberg Prize.

The letter must be written in English and count between 1000-3000 characters (incl. spaces)

There are no strict guidelines with regard to the formatting of the CV and publication list. However, we do ask that it should be as updated and complete as possible.

Information about forthcoming publications or projects may also be included.

In this field you may upload any additional documents that may be of relevance to the Holberg Committee.

PAGE 3: REFEREE SUGGESTIONS

In this section we ask that you suggest three referees who can provide supporting information about the candidate if needed.

To ensure nomination confidentiality we ask that you defer from notifying the suggested referees.

If you have more than three suggestions, additional names may be listed in the "Comments" field.
